We are in the process of getting Aladdin Epayments set up to make money transfers a lot easier for parents to keep track of. This will help when paying for swimming, school trips and school fees come September.

Once Aladdin E-payments is up and running you will be notified through the Aladdin Connect app, we are hoping this will be done before the end of August.

The school fee for the coming school year is \in 50 per child or \in 100 per family and will cover 24-hour pupil accident insurance, photocopying and Art & Craft supplies for the whole school year. The school will cover the costs of all Readers, workbooks, copy books and school journals. You will only have to supply a pencil case with pencils, erasers etc.

The Lunch Bag will continue to supply hot lunches for the coming school year to every child in GDR. We have applied for funding so that Dearcán Bheaga (Clodagh's pre-school) will benefit from the free lunch scheme too.


